The Comptroller is responsible for collecting taxes and issuing refunds, preventing fraud, approving or denying major state contracts at the Board of Public Works, regulating motor fuels, returning unclaimed property to rightful owners, and helping oversee the pension system. In addition, the agency ensures all of Maryland's dedicated state employees are paid accurately and on time.
